The Human Rights Advisory Panel, on 17 February 2012, with the following members present:

Having considered the aforementioned complaint, introduced pursuant to Section 1.2 of UNMIK Regulation No. 2006/12 of 23 March 2006 on the Establishment of the Human Rights Advisory Panel,

Having deliberated, decides as follows:

I. PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE PANEL

- 1. The complaint was introduced on 10 April 2009 and registered on 30 April 2009.
- 2. On 24 November 2010, the Panel requested the complainant to submit additional information. No response to this request was received. On 28 September 2011 the Panel reiterated its request for additional information. Again no response was received.

- 3. On 23 September 2011, the complaint was communicated to the Special Representative of the Secretary-General (SRSG), for UNMIK's comments on admissibility. On 8 November 2011 UNMIK provided its response.
- 4. On 16 December 2011, the Panel declared the complaint partially admissible and partially inadmissible.
- 5. On 27 December 2011, the Panel received a letter from the complainant, in which he stated that he no longer wishes to pursue his complaint before the Panel.

II. THE LAW

- 6. During the course of the examination of the merits of the complaint, the complainant indicated that he no longer wishes to pursue his complaint before the Panel
- 7. In these circumstances, and in accordance with Rule 29 of the Panel's Rules of Procedure, it is appropriate to strike the case out of the list of pending cases.

FOR THESE REASONS,

The Panel, unanimously,

DECIDES TO STRIKE THE COMPLAINT OUT OF ITS LIST OF CASES.
