SRSG's decision in the complaint of Jahja Morina (No. 36/08)

After reviewing the Human Rights Advisory Panel's (HRAP) Opinion on the Complaint of Jahja Morina (Complaint no. 36/08), the Special Representative of the Secretary-General, Farid Zarif, on 5 March 2013, informed the HRAP of the following, in relation to the HRAP's recommendations:

- In relation to the IRAP's recommendation to award compensation to the Complainant, the SRSG wishes to recall that the acts in question relate to activities carried out by the institutions established under the interim administration of Kosovo. As such, had UNMIK continued to have control over these institutions today, UNMIK would have been in a position to refer the HRAP's recommendations to those institutions for appropriate action.
- UNMIK is prepared to discuss the possibility of dealing with such compensation matters with the local authorities at the appropriate juncture.
- UNMIK will keep the Complainant and the HRAP informed about further developments in the above matter.
